# Pima Prevention Partnership

## Program Overview and Background

Prevention Partnership's AZ RISE Mentoring program is a school-based program. The AZ RISE Mentoring Program provides mentoring services to the students in the PPP's Partnership Academy (middle school) and the Pima Partnership High School.

## Program Services

Along with school-based mentoring, students also receive family strengthening programs, healthy relationship education and the opportunity to be part of youth advocacy and peer mentoring programs.

## Target Population

The AZ RISE Mentoring Program serves at risk and system-involved adolescents, 12-17 years old. The PPP schools are located in the 85705-zip code that has an average poverty rate for children of 32.8%.
