Program Services

The mentoring programs are designed to work with children to help them better perform at school and develop good study habits. They use a Character Development Curriculum known as “Possessing Your Power” to provide a way for open discussion on topics including Knowing my Purpose, Self-esteem, Conflict Resolutions, and a variety of topics to build character.

- Youth living in low-income
